

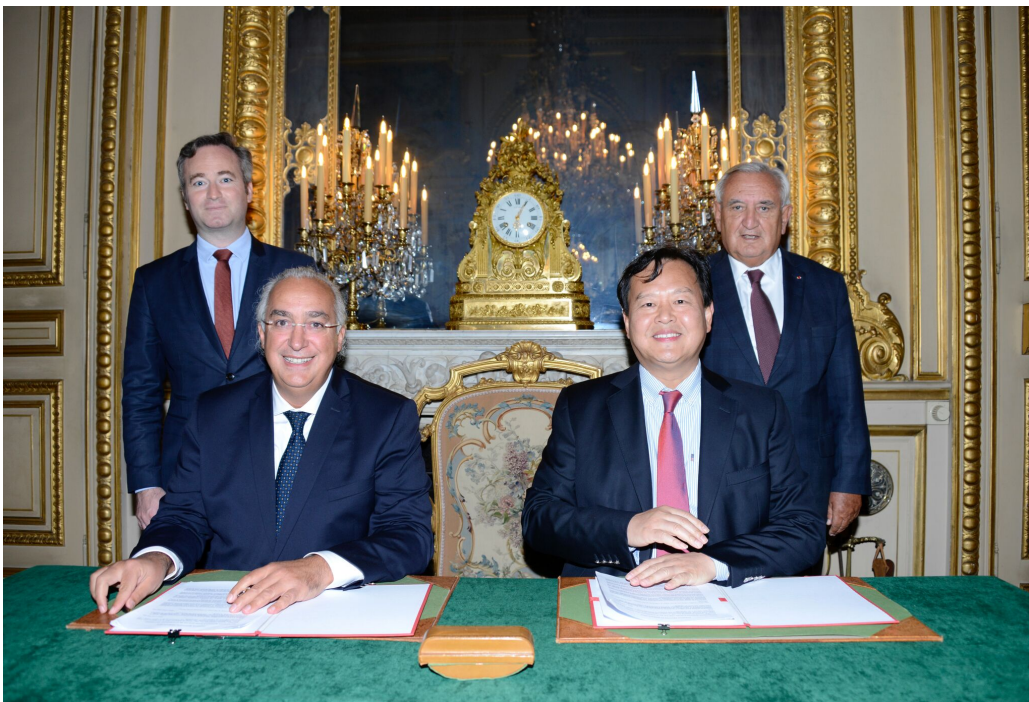

AAQIUS, the specialist in "green" and "low-CO2" technologies has signed an historic agreement with Censtar, the Chinese leader in service stations in China...

... on the occasion of the Paris Summit of the BOAO Forum.



Paris, 15 September 2017 - AAQIUS, an innovative company which develops disruptive projects for green mobility and zero carbon energy in the hydrogen sector, has just signed an historic agreement with Censtar. The agreement was signed by Li Haojie, the Chairman of the Board for Censtar Science & Technology Corp., and Stéphane Aver, the Chairman of AAQIUS, in the presence of Messrs Jean-Baptiste Lemoyne, the Secretary of State for Europe and Foreign Affairs, and Jean-Pierre Raffarin, a former Prime Minister and the Chairman of the Fondation Prospective et Innovation. The agreement was formalised yesterday, in the framework of the Paris Summit of the BOAO Forum on the new Silk Road which ends today in Paris.

This agreement provides for an ambitious programme of work to develop the Stor-H project by the end of 2018: **a launch of 100,000 electric vehicles (bicycles, delivery tricycles, scooters, golf buggies, forklifts) with STOR-H hydrogen cartridges scheduled over 2 years in the economic region of Jiangbei, before moving on to the national level.** Stor-H cartridges are innovative in that they store hydrogen in an inert, pressure-free and safe manner in a complex multi-material and ultra-absorbent medium. Last spring, the agreement made between AAQIUS and the new national economic zone of Jiangbei - under the aegis of Mr. Jean-Pierre Raffarin - represented the first step in this partnership. Indeed, since then, an AAQIUS/Censtar design office has been set up in Jiangbei. It defines the technical-economic conditions for the roll-out of STOR-H technology in China by AAQIUS (300 owner patents).

"The alliance between AAQIUS and Censtar represents the perfect balance between the expertise provided by each of the stakeholders, at the service of an innovative and unprecedented project, STOR-H", says Jean-Pierre Raffarin. The leader in intelligent energy and innovative distribution, Censtar has more than 40,000 service stations located throughout the Chinese territory. It has developed no less than 14 national patents in research and development for fuel and maintenance equipment. Its market share in China is close to 40%.

In the words of AAQIUS Chairman, Stéphane Aver: *"This partnership with Censtar in China, will certainly contribute to accelerating collaboration between Europe and China in terms of the energy transition. We are at the outset of a great adventure, where we will have the rare opportunity to develop the entire ecosystem of our model in China: from building the STOR-H cartridges to distributing them".*
